


## A Trip Down NSB Memory Lane...



### **Beach Season Reminders**

Beach fires are permitted! Please fill out the Beach Fire Application on the homepage of our website! Please read over the safety rules/guidelines, and remember to set up at the proper distance away from the bulkheads, without ever leaving burning embers or wood. Safety first!

Dogs must be leashed at all times! Restricted hours for dogs are on weekends only, from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM, only during the timeframe of Memorial Day to Labor Day. Dogs are permitted all other times and months of the year, and must be leashed at all times!



Please display your parking tag at all times when using NSB parking lots and private roads. Also, please be prepared to show your membership card to staff upon entering the beaches, and have your key with you at all times. And, of course, lock the gate!

To purchase additional keys or parking passes on our website, you must first "log in" to member access on our website, (not "sign up"). Once you log in go to the MORE tab where you will find the EXTRA KEY & PARKING PASS tab. An email will be sent to you to notify where you can pick up your items. Once the beach is officially open, items can be picked up with the beach staff @ Friendship Beach. Also, a reminder that there is a max limit of 3 keys and 3 parking passes.

- Each candidate must be ready to submit a copy of their property tax bill for verification of North Shore Beach property ownership. If elected, part of the swearing in ceremony is to promise to uphold the NSBPOA By-laws. Please familiarize yourself with these prior to the election.
- Each candidate is asked to supply a brief biography which will be included in the August Newsletter, prior to the August General Meeting/Annual Election.
